

## Understanding the Limits of Cannabis Possession and Usage under New Jersey's Recreational Laws

New Jersey's recreational cannabis market has opened its doors to residents and visitors aged 21 and older. However, as with any regulatory framework, there are specific limitations to be aware of regarding the possession and use of cannabis items under the applicable Act and chapter.

## Who can purchase marijuana in NJ's recreational market?

Any individual, whether a New Jersey resident or visitor, aged 21 years or older, is eligible to purchase marijuana. A government-issued identification card is mandatory to ensure that purchasers meet the age requirement.

## What can a consumer purchase?

Dispensaries are permitted to sell up to the equivalent of 1 ounce of cannabis in each transaction. This translates to various combinations, including:

- 1 ounce of dried flower, or
- 5 grams of concentrates, resins, or oils, or
- 1000mg of ingestible products (10 100mg packages) like gummies

A purchase of a combination of products may be:

- 1/2 ounce of dried flower plus 2 1/2 grams of concentrate
- 5 packages of gummies and 1/2 ounce of dried flower

## Where to consume cannabis?

While cannabis consumption is allowed in private spaces, it's essential to note that landlords reserve the right to prohibit cannabis use on their properties. Additionally, consumers have the option of using a consumption lounge associated with a dispensary. However, it remains illegal to transport cannabis across state lines.

In adherence to the law, adults aged 21 and older are allowed to be in possession of a total of 1 ounce of cannabis and cannabis products.
